

Thinking Back & Looking Ahead Georgia State Square Dancers Association Celebrates 50 years!

The Georgia State Square Dancers Association (GSSDA) began in 1972 when a group of devoted square dancers organized to promote, sponsor, and conduct square dancing throughout Georgia; to host square dance conferences and conventions; to provide a source of information and instruction for square dancers; to seek to improve square dancing as a source of pleasure, recreation, physical health, mental health, and wellbeing for Georgia dancers.



Wade & Gloria Driver were the first Presidents of GSSDA. Mac & Virginia McDonald of Macon completed the Drivers' GSSDA term as Presidents when they moved from Georgia. Wade always wanted to bring a National Square Dance Convention® to Georgia.

Two of the objectives of the organization are to sponsor annual Georgia State Convention and to bid for and obtain the National Square Dance Convention® for the State of Georgia. The first Georgia State Convention was held in Macon in September 1972 and the State Convention has been an annual event since then (usually the 3rd weekend in September).

GSSDA has bid several times to host the National Square Dance Convention®. A bid was made in Atlantic City, New Jersey in 1977 to host the National Square Dance Convention® (NSDC) in Atlanta in 1981. Unfortunately, Seattle Washington was selected to host the 1981 Convention. In 1996, GSSDA placed a bid in Birmingham AL to host the 2000 NSDC; Baltimore MD was awarded the Convention. Again in 2015, a new group of dancers prepared a bid for Atlanta to host the NSDC; Atlanta GA was selected to host the 2019 NSDC. The 68th National Square Dance Convention® was held at the Cobb Galleria and Wavery Hotel, June 26-29, 2019. 4,068 dancers from around the world traveled to Georgia for the event. Third time was the charm!

GSSDA is governed by a Board of Directors made up of dedicated representatives from around the State. Each GSSDA member club also has a representative who serves as a contact with the organization.





Erwin "Sod" Andrew

JULY 12, 1927 - MARCH 31, 2019

Erwin Blair Andrew (Sod) was born July 12, 1927. Sod grew up on a farm in Iowa. He was drafted into the army at 18 years old and spent time in Korea as an MP. After discharge from the Army, Sod attended school in Chicago to become a Machinist. In 1951 he moved to Georgia and went to work for Lockheed Martin, a job he loved and never wanted to leave. Sod worked for Lockheed for more than sixty years, as a machinist and later an inspector. While working for Lockheed, Sod also worked part time jobs, Riches selling men's clothing, Arthur Murry's dance studio as an instructor, and for a Machine shop he would later own. For Many years he was a Santa Claus for Lockheed and for a tree farm. Sod, over the years, has been a member of the Chamber of Commerce in Cobb County, City of Atlanta and Marietta. Sod had a passion

for dance from childhood till the day he passed. He taught ballroom dancing, and was a member, dance instructor, soundman & caller with the Georgia State Square Dance Association from the 1950's until his death. Sod enjoyed traveling all over the country to dance events. He was a generous man who worked hard, took care of his parents, his friends and was always willing to help anyone to help themselves.

Sod attended many National Conventions representing Georgia in the Showcase of Ideas display. He would hand out Georgia Peanuts to those visiting the Georgia table in the Showcase of Ideas.



Sylvia Eunice Irvin

Mrs. Sylvia Eunice Irvin, age 81, of Acworth, GA, passed away on Saturday, August 14, 2021, at Wellstar Kennestone Hospital in Marietta, GA.

love and devotion to her family.



Later they focused on round dance clubs, and for a while danced four nights a week. In the late 1990's, Jim and Karen hosted quarterly round dance weekends with national cuers for several years.

In 2008, Jim and Karen returned to square dancing with the T-Squares, and then KSD, once again serving as presidents, then treasurers.

Square and round dancing were deeply important to Jim for 30 years until he passed away August 9th, 2020. Jim always believed that his dancing friends were his family.

Like many of us, Robin Achille (April 18,1948 – June 24,2021) was introduced to square dancing in High School. Through the years she she did various styles of ballroom and other dance genres. Two years ago Robin started round dance lessons and continued to enjoy both square and round dancing. Robin was a member of the Kennesaw Square Dealers for a number of years and danced at many of the square dance clubs in the north metro Atlanta area with them and later as an independent dancer.









Tribute to Jerry Story



Jerry Lee Story age 65 of Fairfield, passed away Saturday, December 19, 2020, at the University of Iowa Hospital and Clinic. Prior to his death, he was in the ICU Unit of Iowa University Hospital for almost 4 weeks undergoing multiple surgeries, an amputation of his leg, and a barrage of tests.

Jerry was born June 21, 1955, to Kenneth and Marian (Hammond) Story in Keokuk, IA. He married Kristine Sue Laux on July 25, 1976 in Fairfield, Iowa. Jerry graduated from Fairfield High School Class of 1973. He was an International Square Dance caller and local business owner. Jerry enjoyed shooting pool and going to the gun range.

He was a Green Bay Packers fan and enjoyed watching FOX news. Jerry used his love of music to honor the Lord by making a Gospel CD Wings of a Dove. Jerry was known for his sense of humor and his story telling. What he loved most was spending time with his kids and grandkids.

Jerry had been a full-time caller for over 40 years calling in all 50 states and numerous foreign countries. In the square dance world, his was truly a household name. Jerry had devoted his life to our great activity. His amazing choreography and unbridled enthusiasm have thrilled thousands and thousands of dancers worldwide for almost half a century. He has taught hundreds of callers in various caller schools. He was the pioneer in getting the SSD Program established. He will be remembered as one of the best callers our activity has produced.



Willis Crump Northeast Georgia Federation (NEGF)



Willis Crump has faithfully served for 25 years on the Georgia State Square Dancers Association (GSSDA) Board, retiring October 2019. On behalf of the GSSDA Board, we present him with the GSSDA Service Award and a big *Thank You!* for his many years of service and dedication. Willis Crump served on the GSSDA Board Jan 1994 – Oct 2019, 25 years.

In 1989, Willis was the Front-End Manager at a local grocery store. The parents of a young man that worked with him were square dancers and invited him to come to class. Willis challenged the young man to go to class and they went, however, the young man dropped out after one week. Willis continued taking square dance lessons with Buddy Phillips and graduated in 1989.

After a few years of dancing, Willis volunteered to serve on the Northeast Georgia Federation (NEGF) Board representing his club. During the years on the NEGF Board he served as the Representative for Scottish Rights Charity and NEGF President twice. He was always eager to help where needed.



In 1994, Willis volunteered and became a member of the Georgia State Square Dancers Association (GSSDA) Board. However, during this time, to hold an Office you had to be



married, they did not elect single members to hold Office. In 2003 Willis was elected GSSDA President to complete Bernard & Sandra Lowe's term. Willis became the first single President of GSSDA. The GSSDA Officers hold office for a two-year period. He

would continue to hold the GSSDA President position in 2004, 2010, 2015 to complete Rich & Shea Meincke's term, 2016, and 2018 resigning from the GSSDA Board in October 2019.

Willis enjoyed dancing and frequently took additional classes learning to Clog and Round Dance. Sam Rowen taught Willis how to Clog Dance. Willis also took Round Dance classes, often partnering with a single lady who many times ended up married to someone else before they finished lessons. Willis would attend dances as a Solo dancer and often dance with married ladies whose husband was unable to dance. Eventually, Willis would partner with Mrs. Weeze (Louise) Purcell whose husband didn't dance. Often, Willis' parents would come to the dances and enjoyed watching the dancers.

Willis has been a member of Currahee Squares, Toccoa GA, holding Club Office numerous times throughout the years. In the 1990's, Currahee held "Super Sunday Special" dances with Sam Lowe. They would invite traveling callers that would be passing through the area to stop into the dance. In March 1995, they had 32 squares on the floor with Gary Shoemake calling. This just happened to be Willis' birthday – what a celebration!

He was instrumental in starting a new club, Fun Time Squares, in Winder GA. Keith Lester was the caller. The Georgia Mountain Getaway ran for 13 years. Willis served as the Event Chairman with Theo & Linda Johnson as Presidents and Don & Rose Griffith as Secretary. This was a fun dance that many enjoyed attending.

Carol Slentz Heart of Georgia Federation





The Heart of Georgia Federation hosted the dance at which Carol Slentz received recognition for her long-time service on the Board of the Georgia State Square Dancer Association. Angie and Louis McClure, Presidents of the Association, attended the Federation's Halloween Dance in Macon on Friday, October 29th and presented Carol with flowers and a beautiful, engraved Service Award for her 24

years of participation on the GSSDA Board. The award read: "In recognition & appreciation of your 24 years of

service, January 1995 to October 2019". Right now, that award is in a proud place of honor at Carol's home on her mantel.

Carol is a born and bred Georgia girl. Born near Augusta, and currently living in the country between Macon and Gray. She raised a family here and before retiring, worked as a bookkeeper with the Georgia Forestry Commission first in Milledgeville and then in Macon.



When asked what offices she had held over the years in her clubs, she laughed and said, "All of them!" This goes along with her idea that "If you don't get involved, there's not much to you!".

On the state level, Carol worked at our State Conventions in a number of different areas over the years. Among other jobs, she has worked with youth dance groups, hospitality - making sure that state convention volunteer callers and cuers were well fed, and frequently managed the Welcome Table to greet attendees arriving at the Convention. "I just did what needed to be done."

Carol joined the GSSDA's Board when face to face meetings were being held. This meant that coming from the Macon area & going to a meeting in the Atlanta area, took at least a half day's time. These meetings were held three to five times a year, so Carol committed a good bit of time and energy to the State Board.


